## 3. Status Reports

- a. Construction Schedule, Feasibility, & Design Status BCPS/MSA
  - Year 1
    - Delivered: Frederick & Fort Worthington (SY 2018 start); Lyndhurst & Dorothy I. Height, formerly John Eager Howard (5/18/18 school start)
    - o Under construction: Robert Poole, Arundel, Cherry Hill, Forest Park, Pimlico
    - o Pre-Construction
      - Patterson: 90% CDs are complete and under review. The school currently has an existing bus pad on Kane Street and it will remain in place for the new school. Soil remediation options are being considered – MDE will issue their opinion to BCS, BCS will issue their opinion, and a revised EAP request including remediation will follow.
      - Arlington: GMP contract negotiations are underway.
      - John Ruhrah: 100% DDs are in for review. UDARP #1, #2, and initial CHAP Meeting are completed. SPRC being scheduled. CHAP Meeting to be scheduled. City Planning is addressing site plan issues separately.
      - Calvin M. Rodwell: The project is currently at 50% CD. UDARP #2 is completed. SPRC scheduled for February 28th. UDARP Wrap-Up Meeting scheduled for March 27th. IAC Review Comments should be completed March 28th (minor comments).
      - Bay-Brook: 100% DDs completed March 1st. UDARP #2 occurred February 15, but exterior architecture was not developed enough – going back to UDARP in March. Pre-UDARP #2 scheduled for March 27th and UDARP #2 scheduled for April 12th. IAC Review Comments should be completed March 26th (minor comments).
      - Fairmount–Harford: 100% DDs are due February 28th and GMP is in negotiation. UDARP completed except for Wrap-up Meeting. UDARP #2 to be scheduled and Wrap-Up Meeting will be needed.
      - Govans: A/E and CM procurement is underway. Awaiting BPW approval March 28th.
      - Medfield: A/E and CM procurement is underway. Awaiting BPW approval March 28th.
      - Mary Rodman: Concept Design received and is being reviewed. UDARP #1 being scheduled for May.
      - Walter P. Carter: Concept Design received and is being reviewed. Pre-UDARP #1 is scheduled for March 27th and formal UDARP #1 is scheduled for April 12th.

# • Outstanding design issues

- Mary E. Rodman: Concern about lack of play space. City Schools/MSA will convene meeting with BCRP (Bob Wall) and DOP (Kyle Leggs and MC Buettner) to resolve sharing of rec and school space to meet needs.

# b. Status of Fiber Connection

The solicitation issued by BCPS in September 2017 for dark fiber based on their projected consumption for the next 10 years is completed. The successful respondent was ENA (Education Networks of America). ENA is currently in charge of the City WAN. They are a full service provider, providing service, equipment and warranties for an initial 5 year period with 2 potential renewals thereafter. BCS confirmed School Board approval of the contract.

# 4. Present Final MOU for Cooperative Use Spaces – City Schools/BCRP

- BCRP Director Moore is working on the final MOU. Bob will get a response.
- BCRP not in any of the schools yet.

#### 5. Planning and Design Coordination – DOP/BCPS/BCRP
