2024 School Relocation Quick Reference





- Don't move more than you need!
- Continuously purge throughout the year.
- Please take personal items (i.e. Plants, pictures, etc.) home prior to your move day.
- Items not needed for day-to-day work should be packed first.
- Place a piece of paper with your name, new room number, and list of contents on the inside of each crate.
- Notify external vendors about your move day
- Leave your existing space in a clean and clear condition.

- Boxes have been delivered to each school.
- Use the appropriate size/type of box when packing.
- Move packets (labels will be delivered)
- Begin taking all personal items home
- Begin packing classrooms, offices and common area as soon as boxes arrive to avoid mad rush of packing before summer break.

Top 10 List: What NOT to do

- 10. Don't switch labels with your Co-Worker
- 9. Don't borrow unused labels from your Co-Worker
- 8. Don't place labels on the top of the boxes; place on side of the box where indicated
- 7. Don't forget to label your boxes and IT equipment (if relocating)
- 6. Don't pack your personal items in the boxes
- **5.** Don't leave your laptop behind
- 🖵 4. Don't pack your own technology
- 4. Don't over fill the boxes
- 2. Don't wait until you arrive at the newly renovated school to purge and shred
- ♥ 1. Don't put a move label directly on your monitor screen; place on the back of the monitor screen
