MEMORANDUM - September 7, 2022

Re: Report from the Interagency Commission on School Construction

MOU §4. IAC PROCESSES

On July 14, the Commission approved the Enhanced Approval Package (EAP) for the renovation and addition project for Frederick Douglass HS #450/Joseph Briscoe SE #451. The approval was made contingent upon the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners (BOSC) approval of a 10-year plan amendment to add the Douglass-Briscoe renovation and addition project to the 21st Century Schools Buildings Program per the MOU process and procedures.

Since that time, staff reviewed a letter from City Schools dated August 10, and other documents provided by City Schools and found no evidence that the BOSC specifically voted to approve the Douglass-Briscoe renovation and addition project as an amendment to the 21st Century Schools Buildings Program. However, sections of the 2022 Comprehensive Educational Facilities Master Plan (CEFMP) and transcripts of BOSC meetings show the intent of the BOSC to include the Douglass-Briscoe project—including its construction—in the 21st Century Schools Buildings Program. Accordingly, staff then informed the Commission that the condition on its July 14 approval had been met to the satisfaction of staff, and that the Maryland Stadium Authority (MSA) may proceed to execute the project per the approved EAP.

In June, staff received EAP packages for three projects: City College HS #480, Polytechnic # 407-Western HS #403, and City Springs EM #008. Because all three projects have been approved by the BOSC to be funded through the Built to Learn (BTL), Pass-Through Grant (PTG), and/or other programs, the Commission will review and approve as appropriate the educational specifications, feasibility studies, and schematic design (SD) submissions for those projects separately as is prescribed for projects under those programs, as opposed to as EAPs.

• Year 1 Schools

- All of the eleven Year 1 buildings, currently housing thirteen schools, are open and occupied.
- The former Patterson building abatement and demolition is complete and the completion of the final site work is expected in October 2022. The Claremont students relocated to the new Patterson Building in summer 2022, becoming the thirteenth school to occupy a Year 1 building.

Year 2 Schools

- Thirteen of the seventeen Year 2 buildings, housing fifteen schools, are open and occupied.
- Northwood Occupied January 2022. Abatement and demolition of the former school building is complete and final site work is proceeding, with completion anticipated in October 2022.
- Cross Country Cross Country construction continues. Storm drain piping and installation of the new water service is nearing completion. Footings, under slab roughins, and slab on grade are complete. Steel erection, metal deck, and masonry wall installation is in progress with completion anticipated in late September. Scheduled for a mid-year 2023-2024 opening.
- Montebello Montebello construction continues. Exterior masonry work and window installation is complete and elevator installation is ongoing. Finish work and AV/IT installation is nearing completion. Floor patching and flooring installation is 80% complete and casework and millwork installation is nearing completion. HVAC equipment installation is ongoing and the VRF system startup is progressing. Scheduled for a mid-year 2022-23 opening.
- Highlandtown 237 construction continues. Exterior brick on the East addition is complete, and brick installation has started on the Northeast addition. Window and curtain wall installation are nearing completion for the East addition and will follow the brick installation on the Northeast addition. East addition interior walls are installed and painted, ceiling grid is being installed, light fixtures have been installed, and casework and plumbing fixture installation will begin in September. Northeast addition ductwork and rough-ins are complete, walls are installed and painted. Existing building AV/IT upgrade rough-ins are complete, ceiling grid is complete, all classrooms and corridors have been painted and locker retrofit is in progress. Scheduled for a mid-year 2022-23 opening.
- Commodore John Rodgers —The AE team chosen for award by the selection committee is led by Crabtree, Rohrbaugh & Associates (CRA). MSA Board approval occurred on September 6, 2022, and BPW approval is anticipated on September 14, 2022, at which time an NTP will be issued. Scheduled for a summer 2025 opening. 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Introduction

Twenty-four of the 28 school buildings approved under the 21st Century School Buildings Program are complete. Of the four schools remaining, three are under construction: Montebello Elementary/Middle School, Highlandtown Elementary/Middle School (#237), and Cross Country Elementary/Middle School. The last one, Commodore John Rodgers Elementary/Middle School, will start design in late September 2022. Additionally, the collocating schools of Frederick Douglass High School and Joseph C. Briscoe Academy Middle/High School (Douglass-Briscoe)

School) have been added to the 21st Century School Buildings Program. Design for this project is anticipated to begin winter/spring 2023.

21st Century School Building Plan Amendments: Surplus Facilities

Feasibility Studies

Feasibility studies are complete for Commodore John Rodgers Elementary/Middle School, Douglass-Briscoe High School, City College High School, and Baltimore Polytechnic Institute-Western High School. An AE has been selected for Commodore John Rodgers EMS. The Maryland Stadium Authority (MSA) has published an Expression of Interest for architectural design services for Douglass-Briscoe School and will receive responses in early September 2022.

Utilization Rates/Surplus

City Schools' citywide enrollment for the 21-22 school year was 77,807, which is a slight decrease from the previous year's enrollment of 77,856 (SY2021). District-wide utilization, not including swing spaces, was 87 percent in SY21-22.

Staffing Update

The City Schools 21st Century Office is currently fully staffed. However, pending resignations will leave two positions vacant: one in September 2022 and one in January 2023.


In April, the 21st Century School Buildings Program department went through an organizational change within the hierarchy of Baltimore City Schools, moving the department from under the Chief of Staff to under the Chief Operating Officer.


The department underwent a structural reorganization due to the change in leadership. The design, construction, and technology sides of the department now report to the Executive Director of Facilities Planning, Design & Construction, Cynthia (Cyndi) Smith.

The community relations and communications sides report to the Interim Director of Strategy & Compliance, Sharrica Bolden, and the financial and human capital sides report to the Director of Operations, which is currently vacant. Both of these positions are under the Executive Director of Operations, Monique Roumo.

The maintenance team has also undergone a reorganization. Three directors - Building Maintenance and Operations, Mechanical Services and Engineering, and Logistics and Environmental Health - replace the previous assistant directors and single director. The three directors report to an Executive Director of Facilities, Bill Levy.

Below are the organizational charts to illustrate the changes.





Finance Update

The 21st Century Buildings Program submitted its proposed Fiscal Year 2023 budget to the Baltimore City Schools Board of Commissioners at the end of March. The Board has allocated a budget of \$3,747,726.00, which was approved on May 10, 2022. The final budget, with supplemental requests, was submitted to the MSA on June 2, 2022, in the amount of \$5,159,785.00. This included operating expenses, salaries and expenses for the fiscal year. An appropriations letter is still pending approval by the MSA.

Design & Construction

The Design Office team (Design) continued to provide design and construction support to deliver Montebello EMS (# 44) and Highlandtown EMS (#237) for January 2023, and Cross Country EMS (#247) for January 2024. To minimize the impact of on-going COVID-related supply chain challenges, Design worked with CMs to prioritize and expedite reviews of construction submittals and RFIs to ensure long-lead items could be approved for purchase without delay or, in some cases, to identify alternates for unavailable items or items that could not be delivered within project schedules. Efforts to remediate supply issues were prevalent in all areas of construction, including, site, structure, supplies & materials, and systems.

Design continued post-occupancy work to ensure FF&E items on backorder due to COVID, were received and installed during summer break. In some instances, however, installations had to occur during the school year. The work occurred without incident or disruption to school operations. Design participated in Construction team post-occupancy inspections, administrative/technical follow-ups, and punch list activities.

Furniture, Fixtures & Equipment

FF&E procurements and installation planning continued for Highlandtown EMS and Montebello EMS. Delivery and installations for these two schools will begin November 2022. As of the date of this report, COVID-related supply chain issues are having less of an impact on these two projects. FF&E design layouts were completed and approved for Cross Country EMS and have advanced to procurement.

Ninety-nine percent of items ordered for the six buildings (eight school programs) that opened fall 2021 and January 2022 have been installed, with severely delayed items installed during the past three months. Change orders are ongoing for a number of significantly delayed and/or discontinued items. As of the date of this report, all items on approved change orders are scheduled for delivery by the end of October.

Govans ES is in the final stages of FF&E closeout. FF&E closeouts have begun for Billie Holiday ES, Katherine Johnson Global Academy, and Northwood ES. Closeouts will be completed by fall 2022.

Technology

21st Century onsite technicians continued to provide in-person technical support services at schools delivered in winter 2021 and schools that remain under warranty. After the warranty period ends, technical support will be provided by City Schools ITD Support Services. The 21st Century Technology team continued to design, procure, and monitor the installation of technology packages for the three projects under construction. Final technology AV/IT checks, device delivery, and installs at the Claremont School were completed before students returned to their new building. A dedicated onsite technician is assigned to the Claremont School for six months to provide technical support as it gets acclimated to its new building technology.

21st Century Academics

City Schools has developed an academic planning process to support its schools with creating inspiring education environments. The Highlandtown EMS community identified Blended Learning as its academic focus area and began working on a work plan for implementation of this approach. Montebello EMS will gain stakeholder feedback in fall 2022 to make a collaboratively informed decision around its academic focus area.

A variety of professional learning opportunities were provided to instructional staff in 21st Century School Buildings. These opportunities are indicated in the chart below:

Ongoing training and support have been provided for schools to support instructional technology integration and the implementation of each school's academic focus area.

The 21st Century Academics team continued working with the Office of Achievement and Accountability in summer 2022 to refine the pilot school review process that was implemented in the 21-22 school year. The goal of the school review is to support both 21st Century Academics and the school in determining next steps for ongoing improvement.

Swing Locations & Logistics

There are three schools in swing locations, specifically:

- Highlandtown Southeast Building, June 2020 through December 2022
- Montebello PDC Building, August 2020 through December 2022
- Cross Country Northwestern Building, July 2019 through December 2023

The 21st Century Logistics department relocated Claremont School (#307) into its new space at the Patterson/Claremont Building on June 16th and June 17th. Claremont School was ready for its summer extended school year program, which started on July 5th. Currently, Logistics is planning for the relocation of Highlandtown EMS (#237) and Montebello EMS (#44) to relocate from their swing space schools into their newly renovated buildings, which will take place the week of December 27, 2022. Logistics is working with Commodore John Rodgers EMS (#27) leadership to develop plans for temporarily relocating the school to the Southeast Building. It has

been decided that Commodore John Rodgers EMS will not relocate to the swing space until June 2023 to reduce the impact on student education. However, the planning process will continue.

The FF&E Asset Management process is well underway. The initial FF&E Asset Management inventory tagging has taken place in a total of 15 schools this past summer (2022), and the team has completed furniture back checks for five of the schools. It will continue to work on back checks for the remaining 10 schools throughout the remainder of the 2022 calendar year. The database software, which is cloud-based, has been purchased to maintain/track the furniture for each school within the 21st Century School Buildings Program. The team is working with the software vendor to import the inventory for the 15 schools that have been inventoried thus far. The additional schools moving forward, will be uploaded to the software program by City Schools 21st Century staff. The team is planning to start working on a schedule for summer 2023; which will include four schools from the previous year, Highlandtown EMS and Montebello EMS.

Comprehensive Maintenance Plans

City Schools has just started the process of compiling data and information for the SY2122 CMP. More significant updates will be provided at the next Executive Committee quarterly meeting.

21st Century Student Internships

21st Century, in collaboration with City Schools' Career Technology Education (CTE) Program and Maryland Stadium Authority, is planning its 2022/2023 student internship program. The internships will provide educational and training opportunities related to the work of the 21st Century School Buildings Program. Once funding has been secured, CTE will recruit students for interviewing by the 21st Century School Buildings Program and pair them with site mentors.

Community Engagement

The Engagement team continues to work with schools, communities, elected officials, and others to provide project updates and solicit input from school communities, for example:

• May 12, 2022, the team hosted a building tour for the Claremont School community. Families and staff were able to view the new space and interact with the new equipment.

member will attend to provide building update information and 21st Century "swag bag" giveaways.


- The team scheduled a Patterson HS/Claremont MHS community meeting on September 14, 2022, to update the community and school on the final phases of construction.
