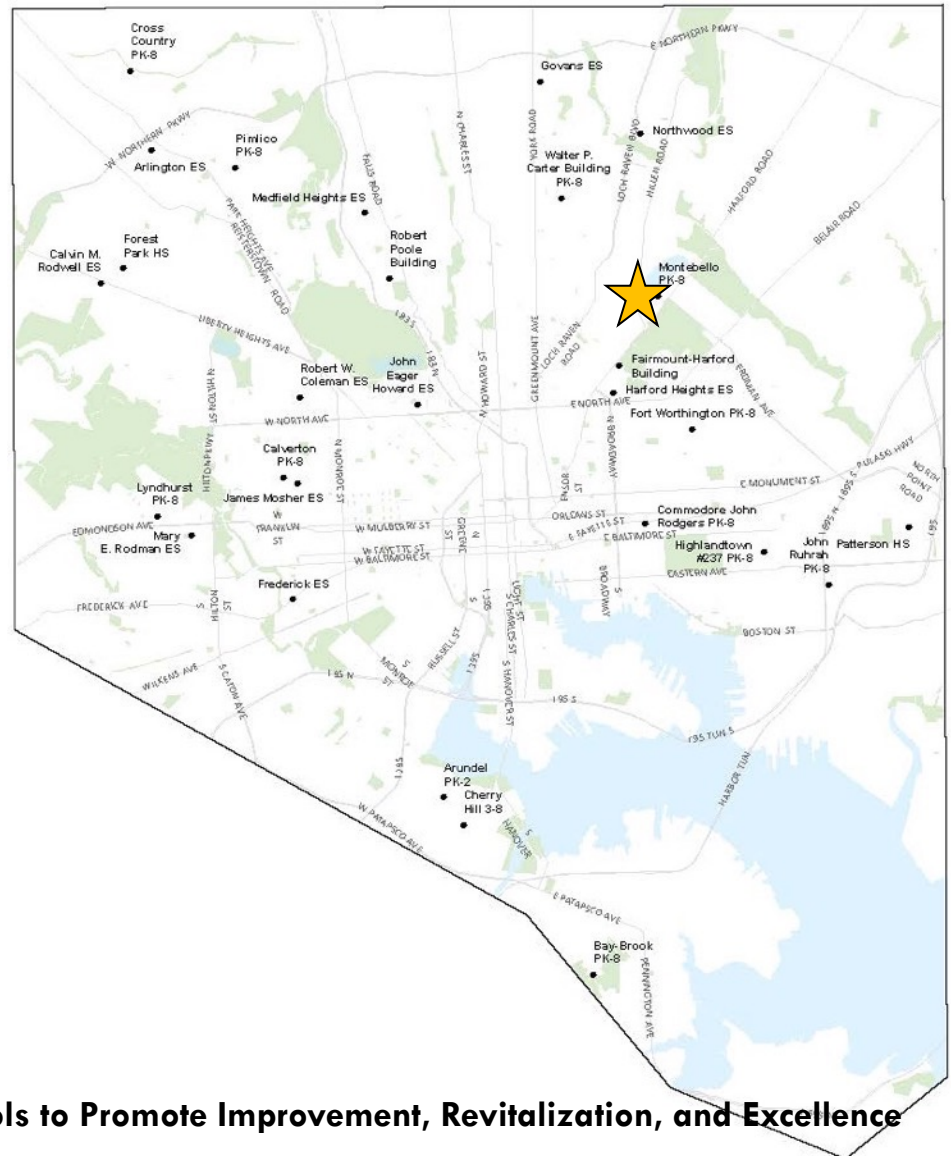
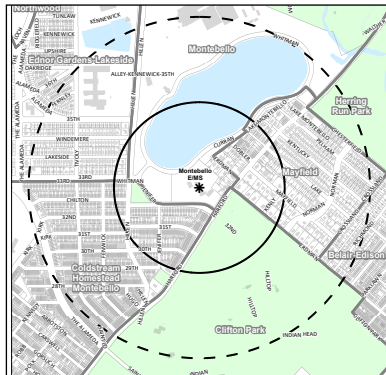

INSPIRE: What It Is

Investing in Neighborhoods and Schools to Promote Improvement, Revitalization, and Excellence

- A **plan**
to improve quality of life and guide community's long-term vision
- A **process**
to develop and begin to implement the plan
- A **budget item**
in CIP – city investments



Activities, Investments, Recommendations



Preparing for Opening Day (Standard Improvements)

City agencies have committed to streetscape improvements

Where: Along the Primary Walking Routes

Examples: Sidewalks, Street Trees, Crosswalks, etc.



Area-Specific Recommendations

Improvements in the environment and quality of life

Where: Throughout INSPIRE area, nearby

Examples: Housing/Market, Transportation, Health & Wellness, etc.



Community-Selected Priority Project

INSPIRE funds a project

Where: Somewhere in INSPIRE area

Examples: Gardens, Murals, Walking Paths, Park Improvements, etc.

Standard Improvements (Primary Walking Route)

Preparing for Opening Day

- Bringing sidewalks up to safe/standard condition
- Repainting/adding crosswalks
- Pruning and planting street trees
- Assessing crossing guard deployment
- Boarding open vacant buildings
- Removing trash and cleaning vacant lots



Examples of Recs & Implementation



- Rehabbing City-owned properties facing Pimlico E/MS
City, private developer



- Turning a vacant lot into Fort Worthington E/MS garden
School, City, BOPA, Parks & People



- Installing a new path in Clifton Park at REACH! Partnership
City



- Implementing a new park master plan near Dorothy I. Height ES
City, Reservoir Hill Improvement Council

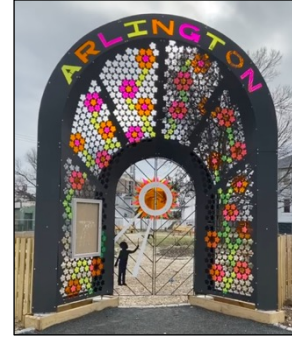

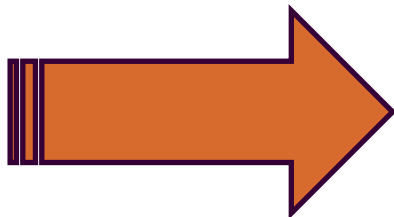


Timeline & Next Steps

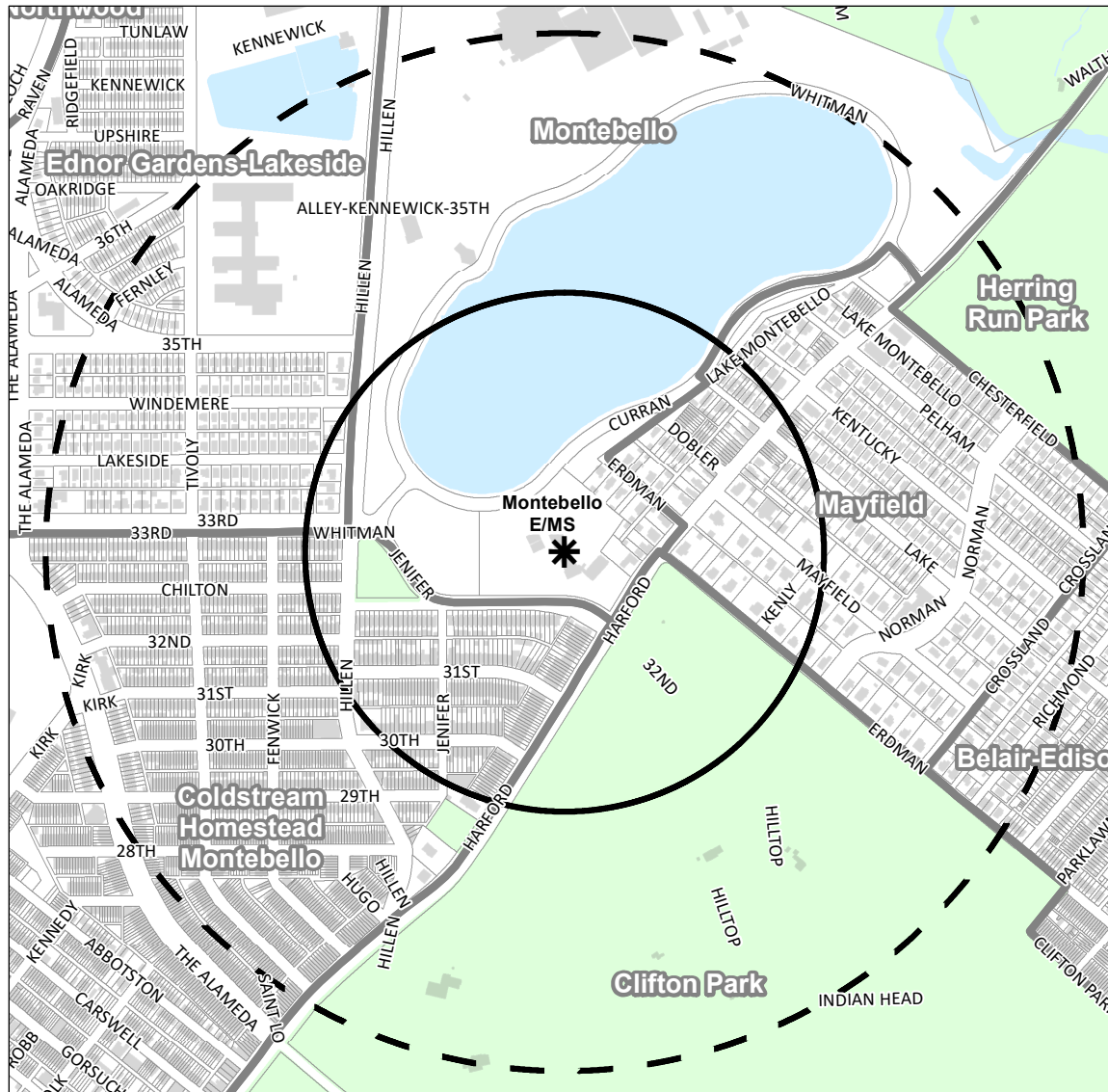
